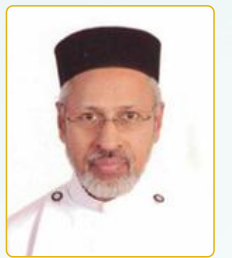
Virtual Vidyarambham ceremony marks the beginning of programmes and activities for the 2020-2022 batch
