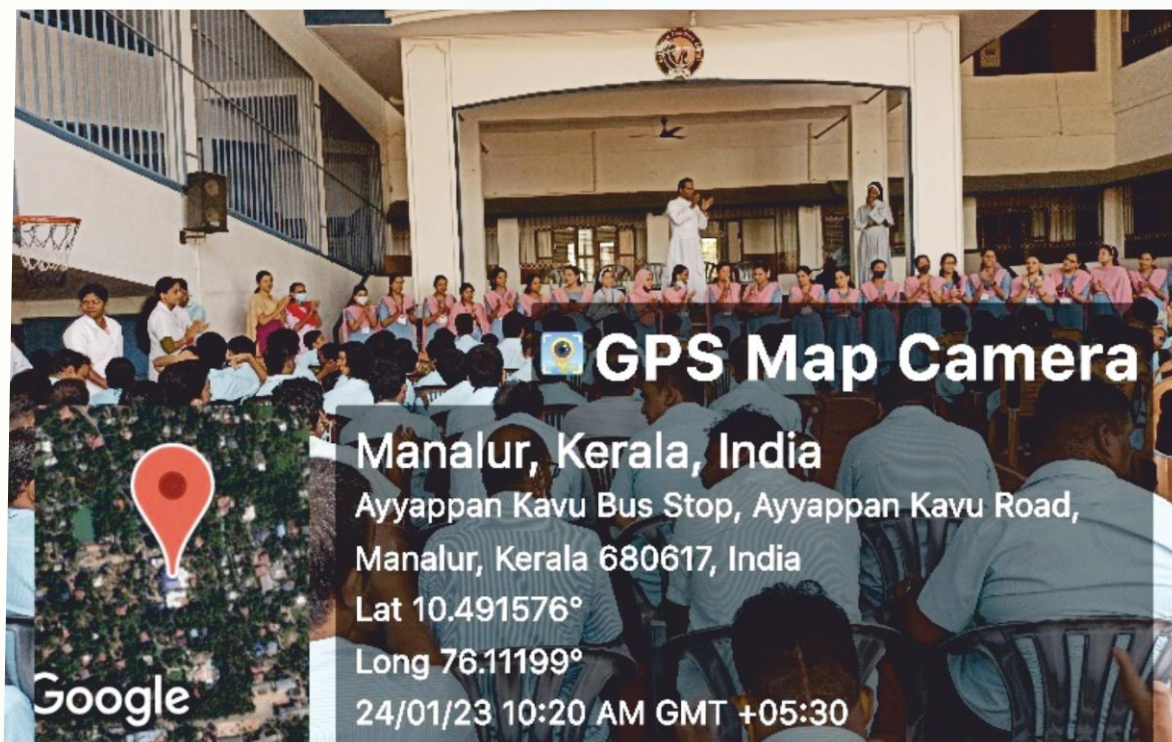
College observes international Women's Day with inspiring event

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St. Chavara Day celebrations highlight educational legacy



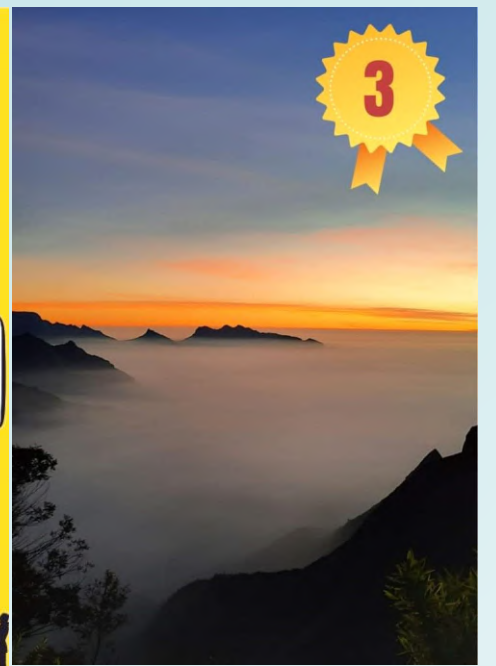
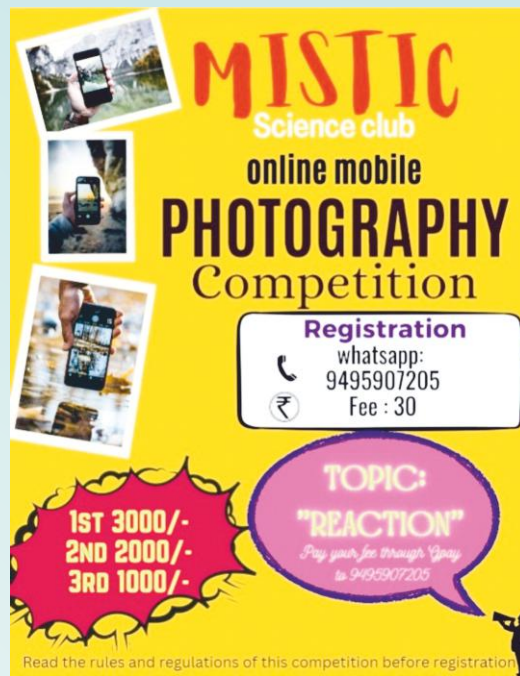

Honoring Excellence: Eunoia celebrates Ms. Lakshmi Rakesh's remarkable achievements



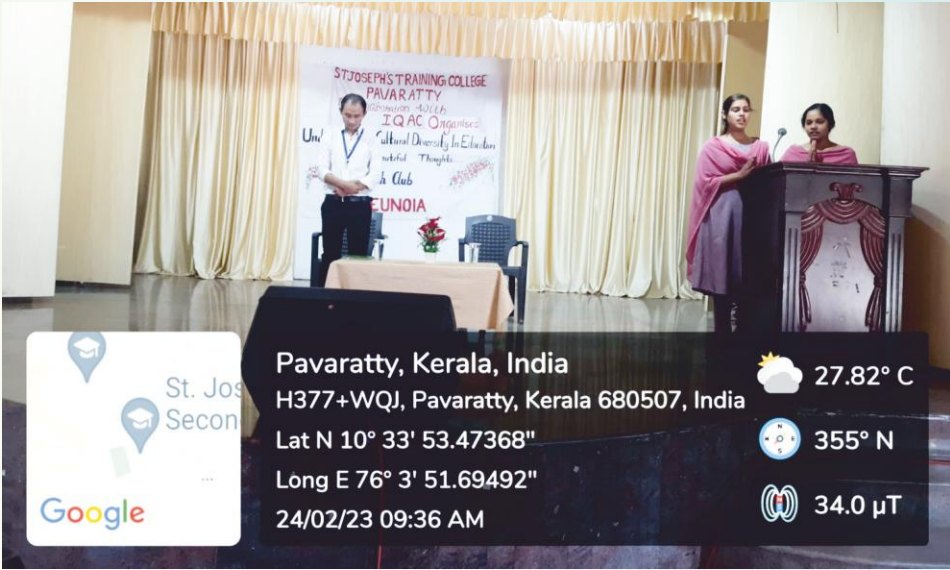
