Installation of CCTV
cameras



A total of 49 CCTV cameras were
installed to enhance security across the
area. This setup includes 40 high
resolution cameras with 4MP
capabilities, providing clear and
detailed images. Additionally, 7
cameras with 2MP resolution, each
capable of monitoring a range of 50
meters, ideal for close- range
surveillance. Two specialized 2MP
cameras offer an extended range of 100
meters, ensuring coverage of larger
areas.
